SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES

OVERALL OBJECTIVE OF THE POSITION

The Rumbek PHCC clinical officer is based in Rumbek and is supervised by the Medical officer / Medical Superintendent when this position will be filled in. He takes overall responsibility on patients who come to seek medical attention in the clinic and in the management of programs run in and by the Health Centre.

1. RESPONSIBILITIES OF CLINICAL OFFICER

- -Managing of daily running of the PHCC programs
- -Manage patients assigned to him according to set guidelines, protocols and standard health care practiced in South Sudan

- -Supervise and monitor activities of technical and non-technical hospital personnel in his department
- Organize and conduct training courses for local nurses as well as providing supportive supervision to other SOH health staff
- 5. Monitor consumption of drugs and medical supplies
- 6. -Supervise Nutrition and EPI programs as well as outpatient clinics,
- 7. Carry out minor surgery
- -Participate in the conduction of mobile / outreach clinics and other community health activities
