#### OVERALL OBJECTIVE OF THE POSITION

The Registered Nurse is based in Rumbek and is supervised by the Medical officer / Medical Superintendent when this position will be filled in. Receiving patients after consultations by Clinical Officer ,she takes responsibility of patients who come to seek medical attention in the clinic and in the management of programs run in and by the Health Centre .

#### RESPONSIBILITIES

## NURSE SUPERVISOR

- -Organize OPD health services
- -Make sure that patients get best care
- -Free flow of patients [no back flow]
- -Training of local staffs and relevant health information according to the programme
- -Make sure that programme items are requested in time eg drugs and sanitation materials
- -Remitting all the monthly reports eg Epidemiological reports, narrative reports
- -Make sure ante natal clinics and child healthcare clinic is running smoothly
- -Make sure patients with complicated cases are referred to state hospital for further management

- Psychiatric nursing qualification and long experience
