


5. The SPLM Leaders (FPD) are in the company of the following dignitaries:

 - (iii) H.E. Tedros Adhanom – Foreign Minister of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia (on behalf of IGAD);
 - (iv) H.E. Amina Mohamed - Foreign Minister of the Republic of Kenya (on Behalf of IGAD); and
 - (v) Senior Ambassadors from South Africa, Tanzania and Kenya.

We urge all the people of South Sudan in their various diversities and shades of opinions to make their voices heard in favour of peace and to call for an immediate end to the civil war that is killing our people, destroying their livelihoods and their long standing social bonds across ethnic divides. Let us all, as leaders of South Sudan, take responsibility for the suffering that has befallen our people and our young nation. We must therefore acknowledge the relentless efforts of all those who are helping us find a peaceful resolution of this crisis and genuinely work with them to achieve lasting peace in our country. Given the immense suffering of our people, it is now time for all of us to say enough is enough!
7. Finally, we take this opportunity to express our deep appreciation to the leaders of our region and the international community at large for their continued support for peace in South Sudan. We urged them to remain seized of the situation in our country.
