1. TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:


5. The Steering Committee may co-opt any member (s) where it deems it necessary.

- To develop the agenda for National Dialogue that is provided for within the framework of the Agreement on the Resolution of the Conflict in South Sudan (ARCISS), and not contravening the terms of the agreement.
- To steer up the process of National Dialogue.

- To work closely with experts and resource persons to help in the facilitation of the process.
- To issue out a schedule/timetable for the National Dialogue process.
