

Executive Summary

This report reflects the key accomplishments, challenges, and financial progress made during the leadership's tenure from January 2023 to January 2025. It outlines strategic initiatives such as the amendment of the community constitution, financial milestones, and policy implementations aimed at improving community engagement and operations.







Achievements & Key Milestones



1.1 Amendment of the Community Constitution

- The constitution was previously limited to seven pages.
- We formed a Constitution Amendment Committee, resulting in a comprehensive constitution, which was passed, approved, and submitted to the Office of Fair Trade.

1.3 Completion of Outstanding Audits

 We finalised the community's audits for the last seven years (2016–2023) and restored compliance with the Office of Fair Trade.


1.2 Fundraising Success

- We held a community fundraiser, raising \$80,636 towards the purchase of a community hall.
- This achievement reflects the community's support and dedication to long-term projects.

1.4 Introduction of Community Event Calendar

- Implemented an event calendar to improve planning, prevent event overlaps, and streamline community activities.
- Welcomed community visitors 11 in the first year and 22 visitors in the second year of leadership, supported and accorded with warm reception and hospitality.





Achievements & Key Milestones



1.5 Community Norms and Regulations

- Introduced an Event Safety and Finishing Time Policy to ensure events conclude by midnight.
- Established fines for overrunning events to reduce disruptions.
- Implemented measures to reduce food wastage at general events, limiting meal preparation to special occasions (e.g., funerals, welcoming new members).

1.7 Collaboration with Other Organisations

 Developed partnerships with other community organisations, enhancing the visibility and recognition of our association.

1.6 Inclusivity Initiatives

- Conducted a feasibility study on purchasing a community hall, which laid the groundwork for the successful fundraiser.
- Established a Grant-Writing Committee to pursue funding opportunities for future community projects.

1.8 Improved Record-Keeping and Documentation

 Established proper documentation and recordkeeping practices, marking the first time these processes were implemented correctly.

 Provided character reference documents for community members in support of legal and government matters.



Challenges Faced

1.1 Lack of Proper Handover

 There was no handover from the previous leadership, which delayed the onboarding and initial operations.

1.2 Limited Community Engagement

• Engagement from some members remained low, resulting in uneven participation and support for certain initiatives.

1.3 Operational Hurdles

- o Initial audits were significantly delayed, leading to compliance risks.
- Occasional difficulties coordinating events and balancing competing interests among community members.



Recommendations for Future Leadership

1..1 Develop a Standardised Handover Process

• Create a formalised handover procedure to ensure smoother transitions between leadership terms.

1.2 Enhance Community Engagement Strategies

 Implement targeted programs to encourage higher participation from all community members.

1.3 Pursue Community Hall Purchase Initiative

 Continue feasibility studies and fundraising efforts toward purchasing a dedicated community hall.


1.4 Expand Partnerships with Other Organisations

1.5 Review the Revised Constitution

 Address the financial year misalignment, ensuring it matches the standard 30 June financial year. This adjustment will help maintain compliance, avoid funding application issues, and align the association's reporting with national standards.

- Proper documentation and financial statements are now in compliance with regulatory standards.


