JOINT COMMUNIQUE BETWEEN TWC EAST NATIONAL MPs AND TECA LEADERS

September 6, 2025

ACKNOWLEDGING that over the past few years, we have been unable to work together harmoniously and to speak in one voice in the interest of Twic East Community due to differences in opinions among us regarding Twic East Community's internal and external affairs;

REGRETTING that the differences among us, as leaders, have impeded the progress of Twic East Community in different spheres of life and caused serious disunity among members of Twic East Community, both at home and in the diaspora;

WELCOMING the participation in the mediation process by Twic East MPs from Jonglei State Legislative Assembly and other Twic East Community stakeholders as observers;

APPRECIATING the crucial role played by Twic East Mediation Team in Juba led by the Primate Emeritus, His Grace Daniel Deng Bul Yak, from July 2024 to August, 2025 in helping us to amicably resolve our differences, reconcile and recommit to working together in order to promote the unity and welfare of Twic East Community;


EXPRESSING our strong desire, henceforth, to promote peace and unity of purpose among various Twic East Community stakeholders, both at home and in the diaspora;

WE, the representatives of Twic East Constituency in the Reconstituted Transitional National Legislature on one hand and the Twic East Community Association (TECA) Leaders on the other, do hereby issue this **JOINT COMMUNIQUE** – having **AGREED** and **RESOLVED**:



1. To reconcile, reunite and recommit to working together to promote the unity and welfare of Twic East Community;
2. To respect our respective and collective mandates as stipulated in various applicable laws of the Republic of South Sudan in whatever we do to safeguard the best interest of Twic East Community;
3. To hold joint monthly or extraordinary meetings during which we shall discuss about and agree on mechanisms for handling issues related to the aspirations and wellbeing of Twic East Community;
4. To reaffirm, without prejudice to good neighborliness, the decision of Twic East Community on its exit from Greater Bor Community as announced during the meeting of TECA General Assembly held at BMC Garden in Juba on October 30, 2022 and Twic East Global Conference in Panyagoor from March 10 -13, 2024;
5. To declare, in line with the decision mentioned in Clause 4 above, that the use of the name “Greater Bor” shall be null and void in all the formal and informal structures; and
6. To respect political parties’ nominations and appointments to government positions, provided that the political parties shall uphold people’s right to political participation through consultations.
